

SUPPLIES for Upcycling Denim Back Pack:

- Sulky Solvy® 1 yd. pack
- 50 wt. Cotton+Steel Thread by Sulky to match denim color(s) for piecing or a quality piecing thread
- Sulky 30 wt. Cotton Thread or another quality thread for construction
- Quarter Inch Ruler (optional)
- FriXion® Pen (disappears with heat) or chalk or water soluble marker
- Nylon (NOT metal) Zipper at least 17"
- Zipper Foot
- Rotary Cutter and Mat (optional)
- Spray Bottle
- Seam Ripper
- Sharp Scissors
- 2 SETS OF 45" shoestrings to match
- Schmetz® 90/14 Topstitch or 90/14 Metallic Needle (www.sulky.com) for construction
- Schmetz® 100/16 Jeans Needle for topstitching (for some machines)
- Dritz® Large Eyelets (15 in a pack)
- General Sewing Supplies

DENIM:

 5-1/2" to 6" Denim Squares in equal amounts of both light and dark denim (about 12 to 15 squares of each)

You can use old jeans, skirts, dresses, or jackets. But you'll want at least one pair of jeans. about a size 14.

Hint: Kelly used a Schmetz® 90/14 Jeans Needle for this project. Depending on the thickness and bulk of the jeans pieces you use, as well as your particular machine; you may need to upsize to a Schmetz®100/16 Jeans Needle for the construction of the backpack.

SUPPLIES for Upcycling Denim Chevron Pillow:

- Sulky Solvy® 1 yd. pack
- Cotton+Steel 50 wt. Thread by Sulky to match denim color(s) or other quality construction thread
- Sulky 12 wt. Cotton Petites[™] (50 yd. spools) in colors to accent your pillow
- #24 Chenille Needle for hand work www.sulky.com
- 24" Quilter's Ruler with 45° mark
- 60mm (preferred) Rotary Cutter and Mat
- 12/80 Schmetz® Universal Needle
- 1/4" Foot
- Spray Bottle
- Sharp seam ripper
- Sharp scissors
- Pillow Form or Fiberfill
- Clover® Wonder Clips (optional)
- Assorted Denim Jeans to deconstruct (3 pairs around size 10.)
