Ephesus

- Population = approx. 300,000
- Hub of financial, political, and spiritual power
- Home of the Temple of Artemis (425 ft. long, 220 ft. wide, 60 ft. tall, w/127 marble pillars)



Acts 28:30-31 – he wrote the "prison epistles" (Philemon, Colossians, Ephesians, Philippians) 30 For two whole years Paul stayed there in his own rented house and welcomed all who came to see him. 31 Boldly and without hindrance he preached the kingdom of God and taught about the Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 3:7-10

7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace 8 that he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding. 9 And he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ, 10 to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment—to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ.

➤ **God the Son** – redeemed, forgiven, revealed

redeemed = apolutrósis = a release effected by payment of ransom, deliverance

Ephesians 3:13-14

13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory.

► God, the Holy Spirit – sealed, guaranteed
