

We've all had the experience of voices "getting into our heads."

Psalms 11 – For the director of music. Of David.

*1 In the LORD I take refuge. How then can you say to me: "Flee like a bird to your mountain.
2 For look, the wicked bend their bows; they set their arrows against the strings to shoot from the shadows at the upright in heart. 3 When the foundations are being destroyed, what can the righteous do?"*

When it feels like "everything is falling apart" – the "foundations are being destroyed"...

What options do we have?

- Flee
- Wring our hands in worry
- Create conspiracy theories
- Focus on evil
- Kick into attack mode
- Pretend that it doesn't impact us

How about this option?

- Dig deeper into God's Word and rely more fully on the Spirit.

Psalms 11:4-7

4 The LORD is in his holy temple; the LORD is on his heavenly throne. He observes everyone on earth; his eyes examine them. 5 The LORD examines the righteous, but the wicked, those who love violence, his soul hates. 6 On the wicked he will rain fiery coals and burning sulfur; a scorching wind will be their lot. 7 For the LORD is righteous, he loves justice; upright men will see his face.

1 Corinthians 3:11

No one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Christ Jesus.

Do not confuse contested ground with a cracked foundation.
