

**Numbers 16:1-3**

1 Korah son of Izhar, the son of Kohath, the son of Levi, and certain Reubenites—Dathan and Abiram, sons of Eliab, and On son of Peleth—became insolent [boldly disrespectful] 2 and rose up against Moses. With them were 250 Israelite men, well-known community leaders who had been appointed members of the council. 3 They came as a group to oppose Moses and Aaron and said to them, “You have gone too far! The whole community is holy, every one of them, and the Lord is with them. Why then do you set yourselves above the Lord’s assembly?”

Numbers 16:31-33

31 As soon as he finished saying all this, the ground under them split apart 32 and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed them and their households, and all those associated with Korah, together with their possessions. 33 They went down alive into the realm of the dead, with everything they owned; the earth closed over them, and they perished and were gone from the community.

38 years later, God instructs Moses and Aaron to take a census and as they are counting up the various family lines...

Numbers 26:11

The line of Korah, however, did not die out.

- Seven generations later, the prophet Samuel is born in the line of Korah.
- The Korahites become doorkeepers and custodians in the Tabernacle.
- King David selects a group of Korahites and calls them out as *expert warriors*.
- Sons of Korah as selected to carry the Ark of the Covenant back to the people of God.
- Sons of Korah author 11 of the 150 psalms. (*Psalm 42, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 84, 85, 87, 88*)
