

“What’s Next? – Renewal of the Church”

We are continuing a journey that we have simply called Renewal. Over the next several weeks we are going to be seeking God for a renewal of the heart, home and church. Renewal means to make something new again. It means something was there, maybe is gone or weakened or damaged and we are seeking to get it back, to restore to what it was before or better.

Renewing the Church is a natural outcome of a renewed heart and renewed home!

Petra – bedrock

Ekklesia - gathering

What’s Next?

Five Strategic areas Jesus has instructed the church to operate in

1. Build – Building the Believer

Colossians 2:6,7, “So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.”

What is Next?

2. Equip – Equipping the Saints

Ephesians 4:11-13, “So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, ¹² to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up ¹³ until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.”

What is Next?

3. Win – Winning the Lost

Luke 10:1-3, “After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. ² He told them, “The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. ³ Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves.”

What is Next?

4. Multiply – Multiplying the Leader

Acts 1:14-15, “They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers. In those days Peter stood up among the believers (a group numbering about a hundred and twenty)”

What is Next?

5. Send – Sending the Called

Matthew 28:18-20, “Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

What is Next?

“The challenge for today’s church is not so much convincing skeptics of the truth of the gospel as it is really believing it ourselves. Believing it in the radical way that compels us to be the Body of Christ, undeniably alive in the midst of death and destruction. That is the improbably plan Christ put in place 2000 years ago, leaving the evidence of His continuing presence in the world in the hands of a motley crew of flawed human beings.” Chuck Colson, Being the Body
