Anchoring ourselves to what we DO know while we journey through what we don't.

Psalm 93:1-2

¹ The LORD reigns, he is robed in majesty; the LORD is robed in majesty and is armed with strength. The world is firmly established; it cannot be moved. ² Your throne was established long ago; you are from all eternity.

- What we do know...
 - Yahweh Malak = the Lord reigns
 - He's robed in majesty and armed with strength
 - It's always been this way

reigns (malak) = rule, have dominion over, to be king

Psalm 93:3

The seas have lifted up, O LORD, the seas have lifted up their voice; the seas have lifted up their pounding waves.

But, what about... seas = chaos, confusion, disorder

Waves, uncertainty, chaos, turmoil tends to launch us toward God.

Psalm 93:4

Mightier than the thunder of the great waters, mightier than the breakers of the sea — the LORD on high is mighty.

- It's a declaration made in the middle of the flood.
- You don't know how firm & secure your anchor is until the waves start pounding.

Psalm 93:5

 $Your \, statutes \, stand \, firm; \, holiness \, adorns \, your \, house \, for \, endless \, days, \, O \, LORD.$
