# **Authorized Pickups**

Please add authorized pickups to your child's brightwheel profile. All students must have at least one that is not their parents. When in the app:

- 1. Click on My Children from the left-hand menu
- 2. Select the desired student's account by clicking on their name
- 3. Scroll down to the Contacts section and click Add Contact
- 4. Select Authorized Pickup from the dropdown menu
- 5. Add the new contact's information & click Save Contact

# Brightwheel Messaging (Admin vs. Staff)

We've noticed a little confusion when parents are attempting to communicate with us through brightwheel, so we want to clarify who is receiving messages. First, whether replying to or creating new messages, only teachers and administrators will see the message. Parents of other children do not receive your messages.

When creating a message, there are two options. One is for communication between you and all staff (teachers) assigned to your student's classroom. The other thread is for communications between you and Admins only - teachers won't see this message thread. When creating an Admin only message, it can only be read by Mrs. Williams, Mrs. Brown, Mrs. Rader, and Mrs. Gardner. Most messages should be sent to all staff.



## Meet Our Team




#### Admin Team
