TRANSITION TEAM UPDATE

During this early part of the summer, the Transition Team has been meeting regularly with Pastor Beth. First, the team reviewed and discussed our church's timeline, our life cycle and what it would take to get us from the "empty nest" phase back to a "growth" curve.

In addition, we reviewed, researched and discussed three potential organizations to lead us in our Mission study, which is the next phase of our transition. A Mission study must be completed before we are able to call our next pastor.

After careful consideration, we invited Gilberto Collazo from New Beginnings to our last meeting. From the website: New Beginnings is a process that will help congregations find clarity and embrace a new vision for their future ministry.

Mr. Collazo outlined a 6-8 month process that has 6 phases. The first three phases include a comprehensive review of our current congregation, an onsite assessment of our facility including assets and programming, a tour of the neighborhood and comprehensive assessment of community demographics and trends.

Next the congregation will gather in a 4- week series of small group meetings to both reflect upon the church/community assessment and to brainstorm about new opportunities in ministry for JKPC. In the last two phases, the Transition team will compile the conversations from all the small groups, discern potential future ministries from that information and then present a future story to the Session and the congregation for further discussion. This future vision information will be key to

help the Pastor Nominating Committee complete our online information and preference characteristics for a new pastor who will lead us into the future.

The Transition Team requested and received Session approval to proceed with New Beginnings. An application is being submitted to them so that we might begin the assessment phases ASAP.
