INTERIM SEARCH COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Search committee has narrowed the list of candidates who applied for our Interim position to 3 pastors. First interviews were completed via Zoom. A second round of interviews will be conducted over the next few weeks for the top candidates. These interviews will be in-person and held at the church so that the pastors can meet the staff, tour the church, and see the neighborhood. Following completion of this second interview, the committee hopes to be able to present one candidate to the Session for approval and offer that pastor a contract. All pastors being considered will complete their current call responsibilities in early fall.

FUNDRAISING REPORT

The only fundraising projects we have participated in since March 2020 has been the Kroger Community Rewards Program and selling of trash bags. Since the church is no longer paying off a loan, the Fundraising Team has made the following decisions concerning fundraising projects that were happening prior to March 2020.

TRASH BAGS - We only have few trash bags left. We will sell the remaining rolls of bags at the discounted price of \$10 per roll. You may purchase them in the church office during regular office hours by making an appointment or by contacting Judy Ricketts or Dick Herman on Sunday mornings. Once the remaining trash bags have been sold, we will no longer be selling trash bags.

CREW CARWASH TICKETS - We plan to sell Crew Carwash tickets in February of 2022 if the COVID situation is such that the team feels it is safe to do so. We have to make the arrangements in December of this year. So you will know in December the plans.

DINING EVENTS - The team will evaluate the COVID situation in December of this year and decide at that time if we feel it is safe to schedule dining events. Since the restaurant industry has been hurt so bad during COVID, it may be that restaurants will not want to do dining events.
