Shopping List

- Download ALL the files:
Select the designs you want to embroider.

- Fearlessly 5x7**
- Fearlessly 6x10**
- Fearlessly 8x12**
- Fearlessly 9x14**

- **5 x 7; 6¼ x 10¼; 8 x 12; 9½ x 14** Hoop

- **Sulky 40 wt.** Rayon decorative threads as specified on the color chart

- **Cut-away** stabilizer (med. wt.)

- Heat & Bond Lite/appliqué paper/Lite Steam-A-Seam 2

- Cotton/muslin; any base fabric of your choice

- 100/16 machine needles or metallic needles

- Sharp scissors

- **For 3D effect**
6" x 9" piece of 2mm thick **(not thicker)** puffy foam

- **For flatter look**
6" x 9" piece of white felt only:

- Appliqué blocks for largest design:

Lilac fabric 8" x 10"
Blue-gray fabric 6" x 10"

Prepare the appliqué blocks

1



Cut a 8" x 10" piece of lilac fabric.

2



Cut a 7" x 9" piece of HeatNBond Lite.

3



Turn over the piece, right side down, with the HeatNBond paper side facing up.

Iron the fusible web to the wrong side of the fabric.

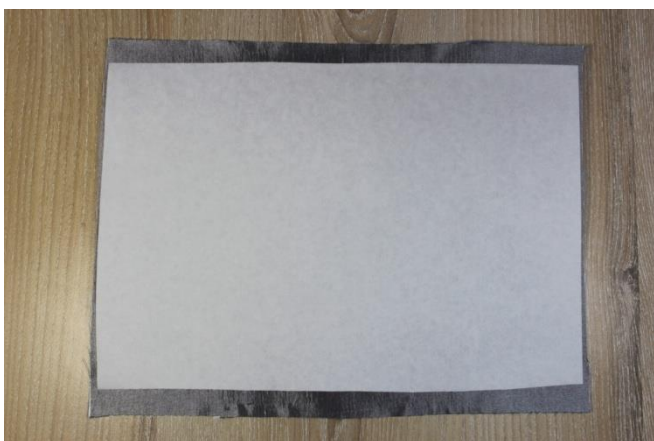
NB! Use a **dry** iron on medium heat.

Cut a 6" x 10" piece of blue-gray fabric.

5



Cut a 5" x 9" piece of HeatNBond Lite.

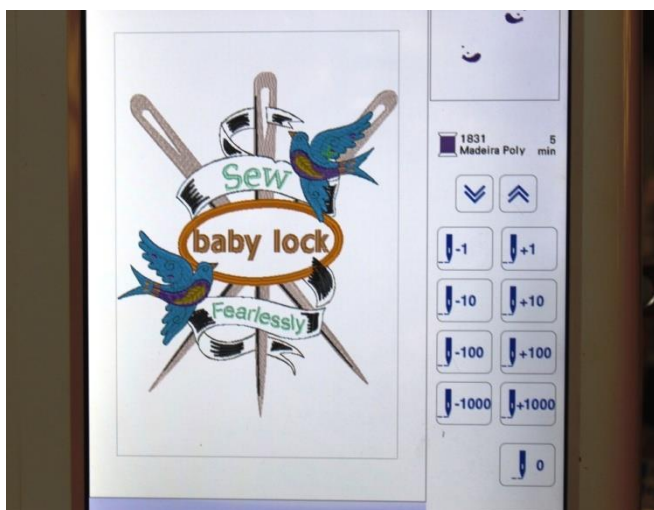
Iron the fusible web to the wrong side of the fabric.

NB! Use a **dry** iron on medium heat.

Appliqué 1	3" x 4" lilac	3" x 4" lilac	2½" x 2½" lilac	2½" x 2½" Lilac
Appliqué 2	3½" x 2" & 4" x 3" blue-gray	4" x 2" & 4½" x 3½" blue-gray	4" x 2½" & 2" x 2" lilac OR 5" x 4" lilac	5" x 3" & 2" x 3" lilac OR 6" x 5" lilac
Appliqué 3	4" x 2½" puffy foam 4" x 2½" white felt	4½" x 3" puffy foam 4½" x 3" white felt	2½" x 5" & 3" x 6" blue-gray	3" x 6" & 3" x 7" blue-gray
Appliqué 4	1½" x 1½" blue-gray	1½" x 1½" blue-gray	6" x 4" puffy foam 6" x 4" white felt	7" x 4" puffy foam 7" x 4" " white felt
Appliqué 5			1½" x 2" lilac	2" x 2" lilac

Embroider the design

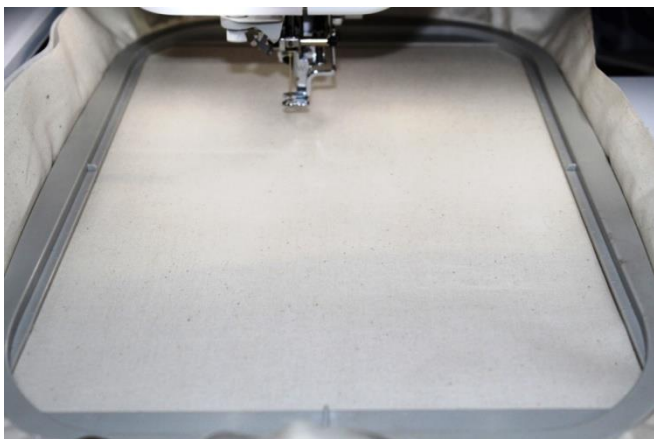


Load the **Fearlessly 8x12** file into your machine.

8 x12 Hoop

Thread the **top** with **Sulky** 40 wt threads according to the color chart.

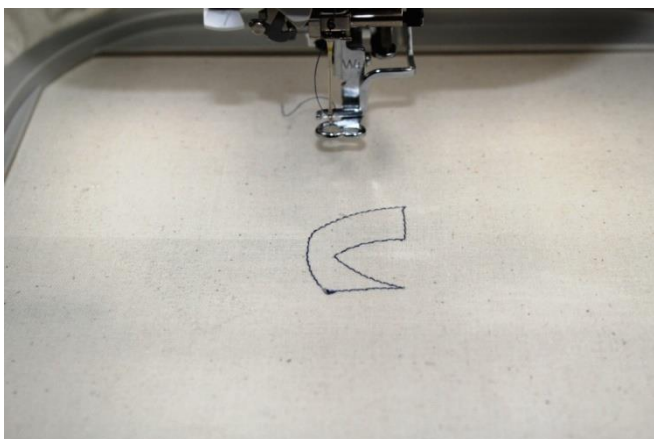

Hoop 1 layer of **Cut-away** (med. weight) stabilizer under the base fabric.

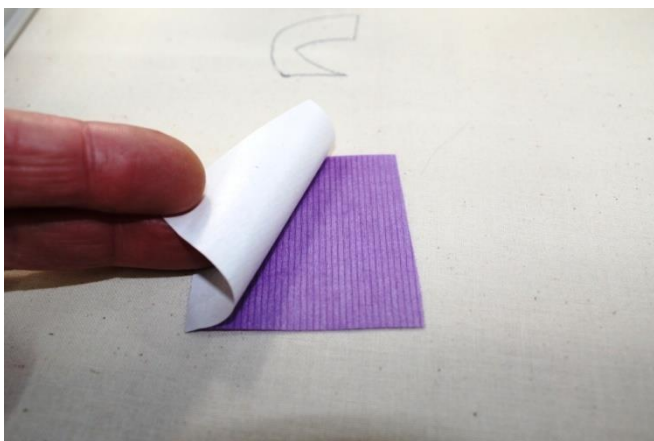
Engage the hoop into the machine.

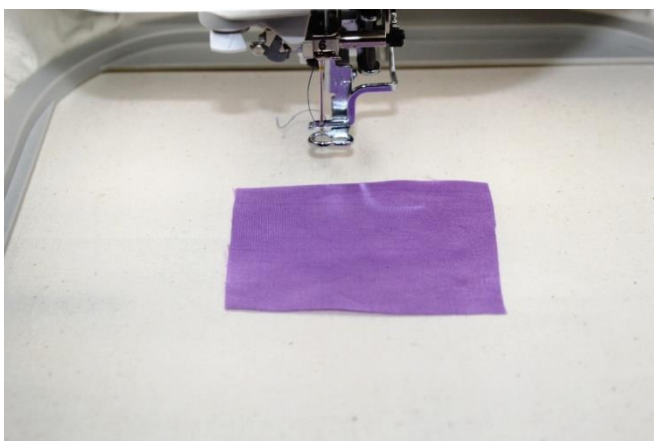
Run the machine to stitch the 1st placement line /guideline.

Pull off the paper.

10



Lay appliqué 1 block with the glue side down over the guideline.

Run the machine to do the tack down.

11



Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{8}$ " (3mm) seam allowance.

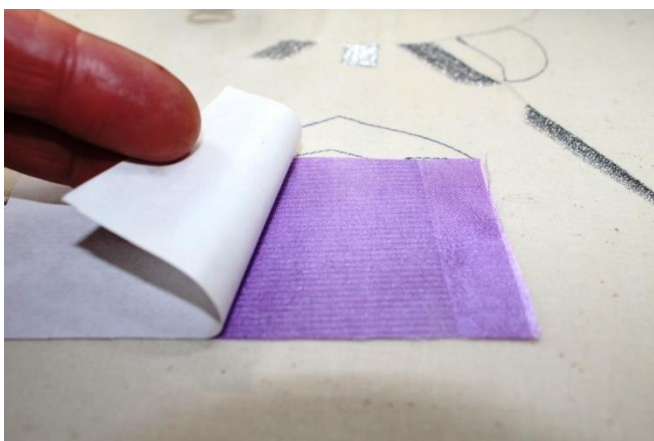
Run the machine to embroider the detail.

13



Run the machine to stitch the 2nd placement lines /guidelines.

14



Pull off the paper.

15



Lay appliqué 2 blocks with the glue sides down over the guidelines.

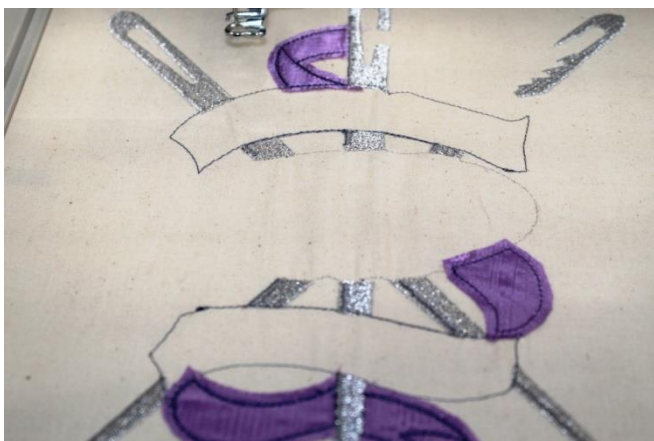
Run the machine to do the tack down.

16



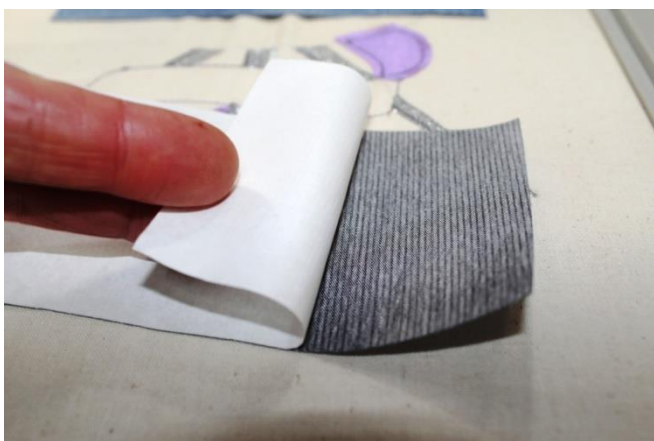
Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{8}$ " (3mm) seam allowance.

17



Run the machine to stitch the 3rd placement lines/guidelines.

18



Pull off the paper.

19



Lay the appliqué 3 blocks with the glue sides down over the guidelines.

Run the machine to do the tack down.

Apply pieces of tape to hold them in position.

20



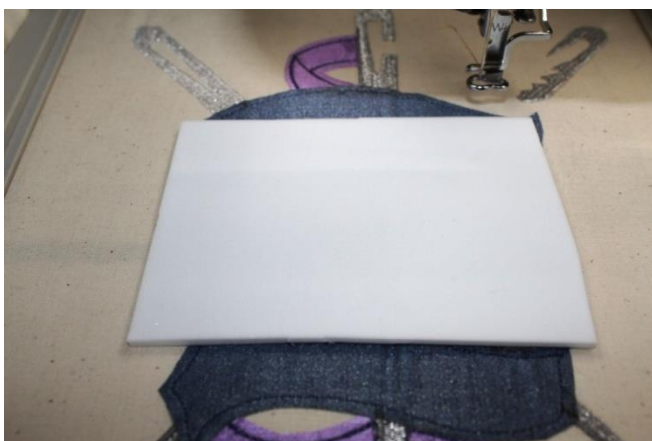
Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{8}$ " (3mm) seam allowance.

21



Run the machine to stitch the 4th placement line/guideline.

22



Cover the guideline with a 2mm thick piece of puffy foam.

23



Place a piece of white felt on top of the puffy foam.

24



Run the machine to do the tack down.

Guide with your hand to even out any potential folds.

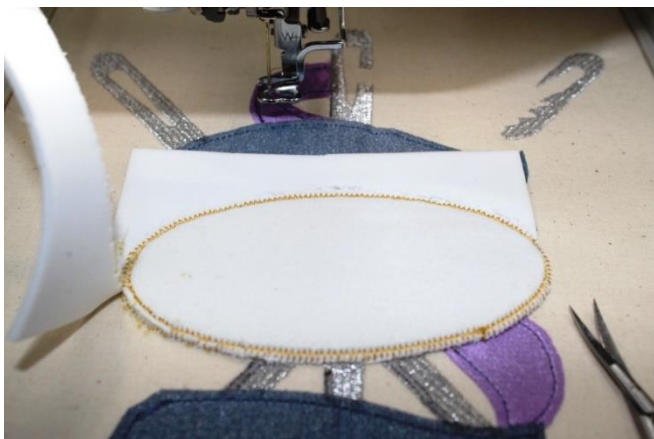

Run the machine to do the zig-zag stitching.

First trim away the white felt.

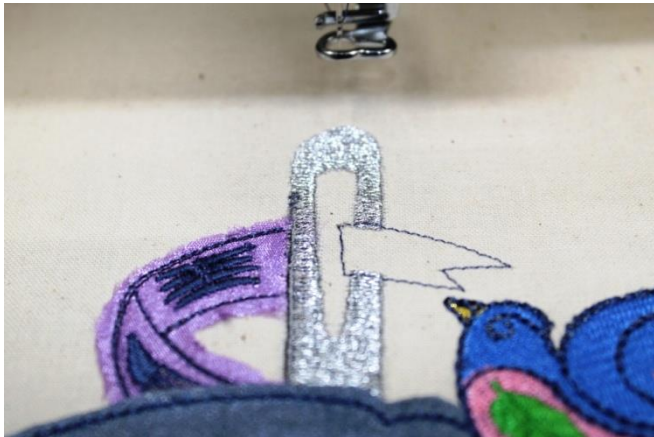
Then trim away the puffy foam.

27



Run the machine to embroider the detail.

28



Run the machine to stitch the 5th placement line/guideline.

29



Cover the placement line with the appliqué 5 block.

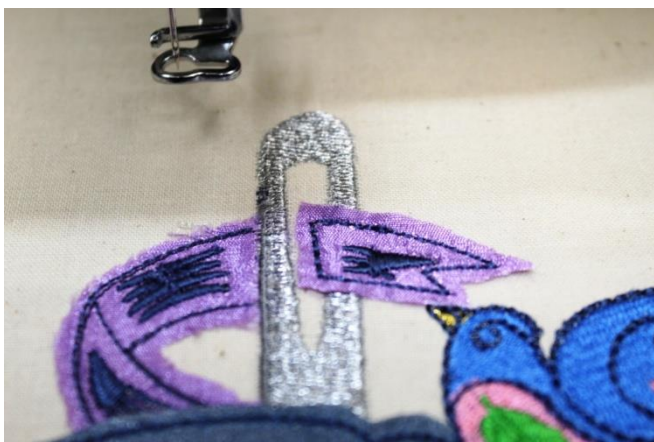
Run the machine to do the tack down.

30



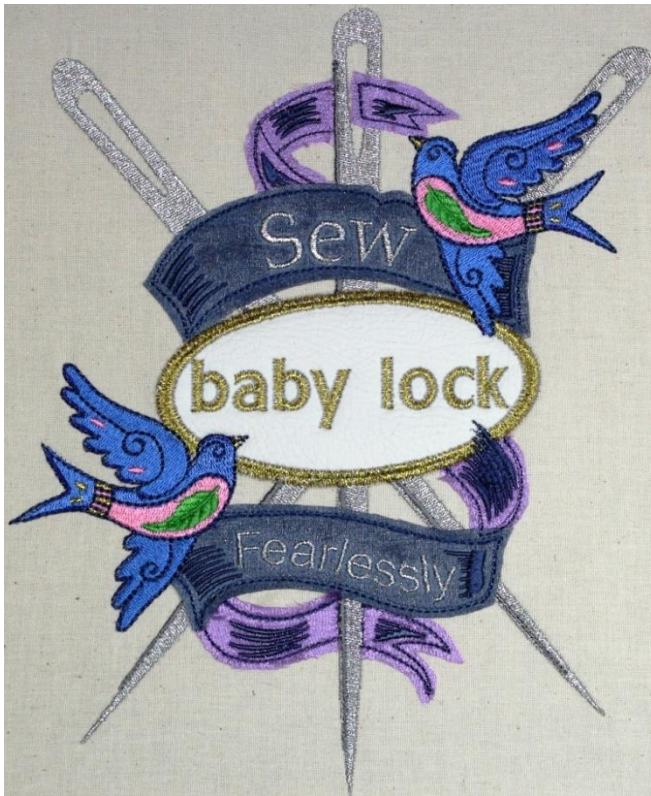
Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{8}$ " (3mm) seam allowance.

Run the machine to do the detail.
