

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Embroidery and Sewing Machine
- One Yard your Choice of Blue Fabric
- One Yard of High-quality Felt
- Navy blue Madeira Aerofil sewing thread
- White Madeira Embroidery Thread for the Designs and White Bobbin Thread
- Swarovski Heat set Crystals in Blue and Aurora Borealis, Assorted Sizes
- Baby Lock Medium Tear Away Stabilizer





Fall Break



- 1. Cut fabric to approximately 25" wide and fold it in half length and width wise to find the center.
- 2. Mark it with an erasable marking pen. Use a grid, perfect placement sticker, camera app or projector depending on what machine you are using for fabric and design placement.
- 3. Hoop the blue fabric with stabilizer.
- 4. Find the center mark and stitch the larger Star of David design in the center.
- 5. Then measure 5" of space between the center design and the placement for the smaller Star of David designs. Stitch those designs.
- 6. Next stitch several dreidel designs around the border. Connect the dreidel designs with decorative stitches so that it looks like the Dreidel is spinning around your table runner.
- 7. Once the Star of David designs are stitched, sandwich the embroidered top fabric with two pieces of the felt fabric with right sides together and pin.

Tip: I found that using a walking foot or Digital Dual Feed foot was very helpful to keep the fabric from sliding and stretching.

- 8. Start stitching with a matching blue thread in the needle and in the bobbin. Leave an opening large enough to turn the table runner right side out.
- 9. Once the runner is turned right side out, finish the edge with topstitching 1/2" from the edge and close the opening that you turned the table runner through.

- 10. Echo quilt around the Star of David, starting with the one in the center one. Echo quilt 1/4" from the Star and then repeat two more times.
- 11. Echo around the smaller Star of David designs repeat. Repeat the steps above twice.
- 12. Once the stitching is done, place and attach the Swarovski crystals.
