## Quilted Pumpkin Table Runner

 (Finished size: 38" x 16")

Skill Level: Beginner
WOF = width of fabric 42" usable width

## Fabric Requirements \& Cutting Instructions

Fabric A - cut (1) $71 / 2$ " x 10" (Pumpkin 1)
Fabric B - cut (2) $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ " (Pumpkin 2)
Fabric C - cut (3) $31 / 2$ " $\times 11 / 2$ " (stem)
Fabric D - $1 / 4$ yard - Cut (3) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strips (outer border)

- Subcut (2) $381 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$
- Subcut (2) $121 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$

Background Fabric E-1/3 yard

- Cut (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip - subcut into (4) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ "
- Cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips - subcut into (2) $341 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " strips
- Cut (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip - subcut into (12) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- Cut (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip - subcut into (6) $43 / 4$ " $\times 31 / 2$ " strips
- Cut (3) $111 / 2$ " $\times 11 ⁄ 2$ " squares

Backing Fabric: $5 / 8$ yard
Binding: Cut (3) $211 / 2$ x WOF strips

## Supplies

Batting: 20" x 40"
Marking Tool
Ruler
Rotary cutter
Coordinating thread
1/4" quilting foot

NOTE: All seam allowances are 1/4". To achieve the correct seam allowance, use your Baby Lock 1/4" quilting foot. When stitching, line up the raw edge of your fabric with the right side edge of the $1 / 4$ " foot, and you will get an accurate seam allowance every time. Set your machine stitch length to 2.5 . This will ensure your pieces are stitched securely.

## PiecingInstructions

1. Using the ruler and marking tool, draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the back of each $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " background square. Repeat with each $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " background square. (Fig. 1)

2. Place a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " background square on one corner of Fabric $A .71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ rectangle. (Fig. 2)

3. Stitch on the drawn line from corner to corner. (Fig. 3) Using the rotary cutter and ruler, trim $1 / 4$ " from the drawn line. (Fig. 4) Open and press toward background (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 by stitching a $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " square to all 4 corners of each Fabric $A$ and $B$ pieces. (Fig. 6)

5. Place a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " background square on the top half of a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip. Right sides together. The drawn line is facing up. Stitch on the drawn diagonal line. Using ruler and rotary cutter, trim 1/4" from the stitching line. Open and press toward background. (Fig. 7) Repeat steps to make 3 stem units.

6. Sew a $4 \frac{3}{4}$ " $\times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangle to the right and left sides of one stem unit. Press toward background. (Fig. 8) Repeat steps to make 3 stem blocks.

7. Place the stem block made in No. 6 onto the pumpkin block, right sides together. Make sure to center the stem in the middle of the pumpkin block. Stitch in place. Press toward stem unit. Repeat steps to make 3 pumpkin blocks.

8. Sew a 10 " $\times 11 / 2$ " background sashing strip to the right side of each pumpkin block. (Fig. 10)

9. Sew blocks together to form a row. Sew remaining 10" $\times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " sashing strip to left side of row. (Fig. 11)

10. Sew the 34 " $\times 11 / 2$ " background strips to the top and bottom. This completes the inner border. (Fig. 12)

11. Sew Fabric D $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ outer border strips to left and right sides.

12. Sew Fabric D $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ outer border strips to top and bottom. (Fig. 14)

13. Your table runner top is done. Baste, quilt and bind in your desired method.
