

TRIAL in the matter of *Beauty v Beast* FL03 123456

Orders sought by the Applicant Mother, Princess Belle the Beauty

PARENTING

1. An Order that the mother shall continue to have the child (Barette) in her primary care in Edmonton, Alberta.
2. A declaration that the parties are unable to communicate and cooperate to make co-parenting and joint decision-making viable, and as such, an Order granting the mother sole decision-making on health (including counselling), education and extra-curricular activities.
3. A detailed Parenting Order setting out:
 - a. the schedule for regular parenting time, holiday time, vacations and special days;
 - b. the mechanisms and parameters for parenting coordination and communication between the parties;
 - c. the parameters of civility and shielding the children from conflict, denigrating and alienating behaviours; and
 - d. the location of exchanges and the sharing of driving to facilitate exchanges.

A proposed draft form of Order is attached.

CHILD SUPPORT

4. An Order imputing the father with income in 2015, 2016 and 2017 corresponding to minimum wage employment such that his 2015 *Guideline* income is set at \$23,744 and her 2016 and 2017 *Guideline* income is set at \$25,376.
5. An Order setting the mother's 2013, 2014, and 2015 *Guideline* income as her actual Line 150 incomes of \$95,740, \$107,172 and \$103,512 respectively, and her 2016 and 2017 *Guideline* income estimated at \$103,513 (her 2015 Line 150).
6. An Order directing MEP to recalculate Section 3 Child Support payable and paid from separation to present: by the mother for the period from June 2013 to August 2013 and by the father for the period from September 2014 to present and ongoing. This will result in a payment owing for Section 3 Child Support from the father to the mother in the amount of \$3,118.

7. And Order directing MEP to collect the father's proportional share of Section 7 expenses incurred by the mother in the total amount of \$1,973 (16.5% in 2014, 18.7% in 2015 and 19.7% in 2016).

Calculations showing the mother's position on Child Support from separation to present are attached.

8. An Order directing ongoing Section 3 Child Support payable by the father to the mother in the monthly amount of \$388, commencing January 1, 2017.
9. An Order directing ongoing Section 7 Child Support payable by the father to the mother in the monthly lump sum amount of \$70, commencing January 1, 2017, which represents 19.7% of an average of \$350 per month in Section 7 expenses based on the expenditures over the last 2.5 years.

OTHER RELIEF

10. An Order directing that the cost of the PN7 Parenting Assessment / Intervention by psychologist be shared equally by the parties and directing MEP to credit the mother's account in the amount of \$2,100.
11. A declaration that the mother has fulfilled her financial obligation to the joint debt for the vehicle purchased in 2013 in having negotiated a discounted amount to clear the debt to the benefit of both parties and having paid her share of this joint debt in full.
12. That the reported Trial decision be reported by the initials *P.B. v. P.A.*
13. Costs payable to the mother on a Solicitor and Client basis.
