§ 56:1. Notice of survey, appraisal, soundings, etc

This notice must be given by such means as are reasonably available not less than forty-eight hours nor more than thirty days prior to the date of entry (RC 163.03).

To: *[name and address of owner or person in possession]*

Please take notice that the City of _____, by its *[agents/employees/engineers/appraisers]*, will enter onto property owned or occupied by you on *[date]* and thereafter if necessary, for the purpose of conducting *[an appraisal/a survey/test hole borings/soundings/an examination]*, in connection with the proposed acquisition of *[an easement/the property/other interest to be acquired]* necessary for the *[name of the project]*.

The City of _____ will cause your property to be restored to a neat and presentable condition after the above is completed. In the event any damage is done to your property as a result of the above, the City will consider a claim for reimbursement or restitution.
