

PLAINTIFF-ONLY CERTIFICATION

I, _____, declare that:

To the extent that I currently practice law or work in the area of **personal injury or wrongful death**,

A.

- 1) I only represent individuals (plaintiffs and personal defendants);
- 2) I do not represent any insurance companies or other self-insuring group;
- 3) I do not represent any defendants that are insured for the loss that is the subject of an action or may become the subject of an action;
- 4) I receive all my instructions from an individual plaintiff or personal defendant;
- 5) I have no files in which I receive my instruction from an insurance adjuster, or representative of a self-insuring group; and

- 1) That I am a member currently in good standing of the Law Society of British Columbia and/or its Provincial equivalent*, and the Trial Lawyers Association of British Columbia;
- 2) I agree to advise the TLABC if the above changes between the date of the certification and the Plaintiff-only seminar that is the subject of this certification, in which case I agree that I may not attend the seminar;
- 3) I agree not to disseminate any of the information or materials I obtain through the TLABC _____ Plaintiff-only seminar to any person or entity who represents defendants (except personal defendants), insurance companies, or a self-insuring group.
