CAOC responds to Gov. Brown's Prop 65 proposal

Calls for ensuring Prop 65 continues to protect Californians

SACRAMENTO (May 7, 2013) – The following is from Consumer Attorneys of California president Brian Kabateck:

“CAOC fully understands the problem with a few lawyers who are abusing the law by sending demand letters to businesses for not posting the required Proposition 65 warning signs. To that end, CAOC has worked diligently with Assemblymember Mike Gatto, the author of AB 227, to find a solution that would eliminate the practices of those bad attorneys by addressing the specific problem without broadly damaging the intent and benefit that Prop 65 provides. We also have been working closely with those in the environmental community who view Prop 65 as a crucial consumer protection statute. CAOC looks forward to reviewing [the governor's suggestions](#) in order to find a solution that will stop those abusive lawyers while ensuring that Prop 65 remains a viable statute to protect all Californians. We support the targeted approach of AB 227 as amended.”
