SACRAMENTO (March 16, 2020) – Consumer Attorneys of California has set up a website for attorneys and the public to find coronavirus-related announcements from Superior Courts in each of California’s 58 counties.

The site, www.caoc.org/coronavirus-courts, will be updated continuously by CAOC’s communications staff.

As of this afternoon, Contra Costa, Sonoma and Ventura county courts are closed, Los Angeles County courts have begun “scaling down operations,” and civil trials are affected in Alameda, Amador, Marin, Nevada, Orange, Placer, San Bernardino, San Diego, San Francisco, Santa Clara and Yolo counties.
