CAOC statement on passing of Ruth Bader Ginsburg

The U.S Supreme Court justice was both feminist icon and giant of the law

SACRAMENTO (September 18, 2020) – Leaders of Consumer Attorneys of California expressed sorrow and condolences to the family of U.S. Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg, who died today at the age of 87. The following statement is from CAOC President Micha Star Liberty:

“The sorrow felt today by all of us who admired Justice Ginsburg is immeasurable. From her days as a barrier breaker in law school through her decades of service on the Supreme Court, Justice Ginsburg was nothing less than an icon for those who believed in justice and equality for all. Her buoyant spirit, integrity and quiet but indomitable quest to ensure fairness for all Americans no matter their race, gender, sexual orientation or income status were hallmarks of a diminutive woman who was a giant of the law. And she was tough. We will never forget her statement about gender equity: ‘I ask no favor for my sex. All I ask of our brethren is that they take their feet off our necks.’ Ruth Bader Ginsburg is destined to go down in history as one of our country’s most towering legal minds and greatest Supreme Court justices. And it must be said: With barely six weeks until Election Day, our hope is that those in Congress responsible for confirming her successor on the court will take into account the precedent they set in 2016 and delay the confirmation process until after the inauguration. Otherwise, they risk going down as history’s biggest hypocrites.”
