CAOC statement on the police killing of George Floyd in Minneapolis and nationwide civil protests

SACRAMENTO (June 2, 2020) – Consumer Attorneys of California President Micha Star Liberty and CEO Nancy Drabble issued the following statement today on the killing of George Floyd by a Minneapolis police officer last week and the resulting social unrest that has swept the nation:

“In this moment of our shared history we have the opportunity and obligation to define who we are as an organization. We must rise up, answer the call to action and stand in solidarity with Black citizens and all communities of color. It takes more than just recognizing and celebrating diversity. It takes more than just speaking out against social injustice. We must endeavor to eradicate these perennial acts of violence. It is time for real change.”
