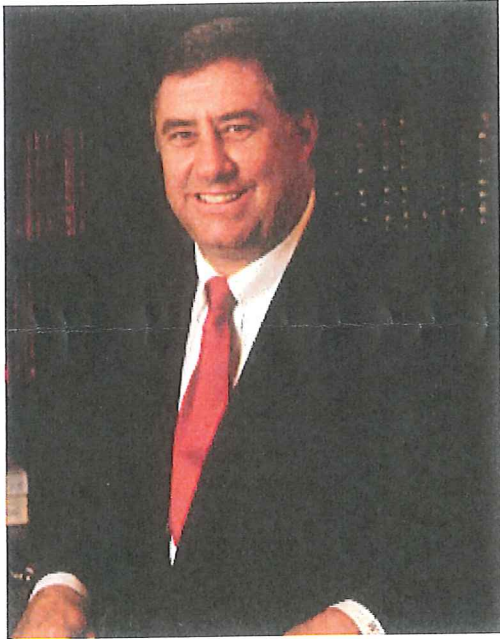


# William J. Weber, Jr.
