Ancillary Events Policy
Adopted March 10, 2020

DTLA is grateful for the support and participation of its convention exhibitors and wants you to have as captive an audience as possible. DTLA also understands exhibitors often attempt to maximize their participation in the convention by holding ancillary events for attorneys. An ancillary event is any function held in adjunct to the convention by a group other than DTLA.

It is the policy of the DTLA Board of Governors that ancillary events may NOT be scheduled while official convention events are occurring. This policy shall be in effect for the duration of the annual convention, which starts Friday morning at 8 am and concludes Friday evening at 7 pm. The convention resumes on Saturday morning at 8 am and concludes at noon.

Exhibitors and/or sponsors who fail to abide by this policy may lose exhibit and/or sponsorship privileges at future DTLA events. If the company hosting an ancillary event is not currently an exhibitor and/or sponsor, the company may forfeit an opportunity to exhibit at or sponsor future DTLA events.
