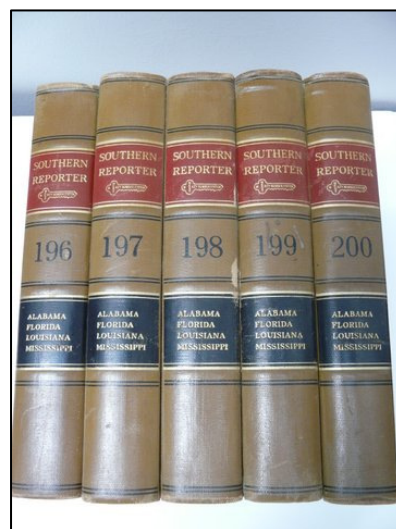
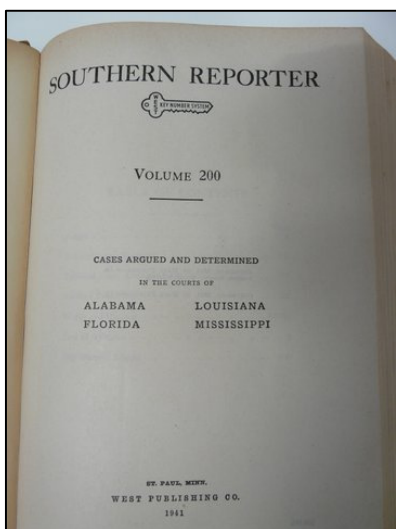
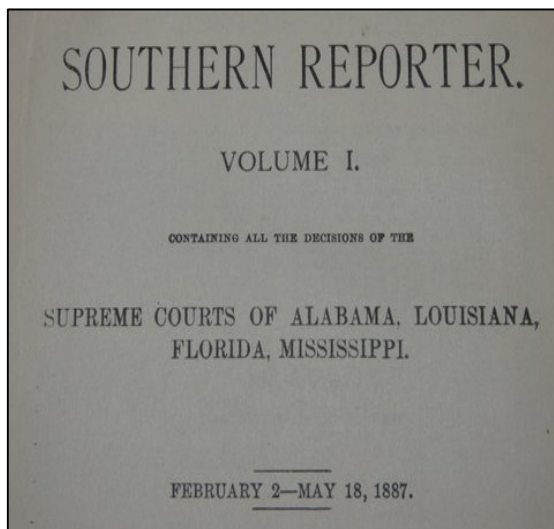
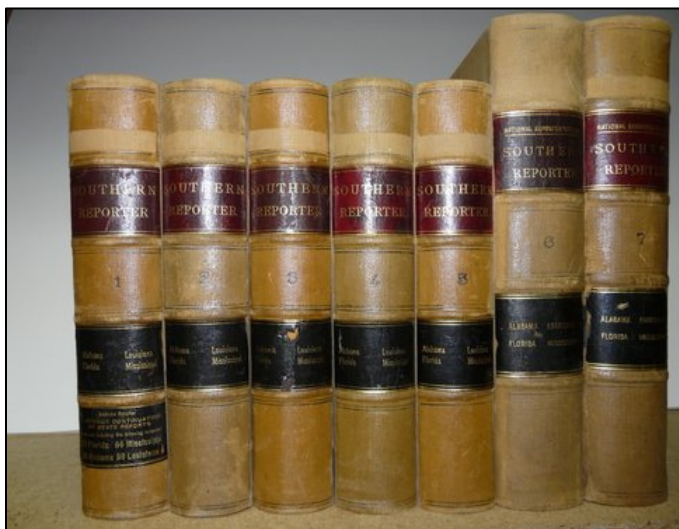
Southern Reporter 1st Series -- *Rare Original Printing!*

These books are up to 125 years old, and, as can reasonably be expected, their condition varies in proportion to their age. Most of the books (the newest of which is *only* 71 years old) are in **very good to excellent condition** for their age, but three of the four oldest volumes do have minor internal damage and one has moderate internal damage (none of the internal damage detracts from the external appearance of shelved books).

Most of the books are the size of current Southern Reporters; however, Volumes 1-5 are somewhat smaller than the later books. Displaying the full set will require about 30 linear feet of shelving.

All volumes are stamped with the name of **Victor Tipton's** law firm on the inside. Volumes 147-200 are also stamped on the outside cover with the name of another firm. None of the books have any firm identification on the spine.
