2020 SCHOLARSHIP**

The Construction Law Section of the Houston Bar Association (“**HBA**”) is currently accepting applications for the section’s scholarship which will be awarded to a second or third year law student from each of the three Houston area law schools (University of Houston, South Texas College of Law Houston, and Thurgood Marshall School of Law) with a demonstrated interest in construction law. The application is attached.

AWARDS GIVEN: A total of \$1,000 in scholarship funds per school will be awarded to students at each of the three Houston area law schools (University of Houston, South Texas College of Law Houston, and Thurgood Marshall School of Law). The committee will select one student from each school to award the \$1,000.

ELIGIBILITY: Any current second or third year law student currently enrolled at a law school listed above who has earned at least 30 credit hours is eligible to apply.

CRITERIA: Scholarships will be awarded to applicants who have a demonstrated interest in construction law.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Applications must be received no later than **5:00 p.m. CST on Friday, April 17, 2020.**

RECOGNITION EVENT: Scholarship recipients will be recognized at a future HBA Construction Law Section lunch meeting and online.
