### **Books Between Kids**

- Book Use: We have partnerships with HISD and Humble schools as well as Houston Food Bank and Kids Meals. We do annual distributions of 6 books/child at schools, and monthly donations to Food Bank Backpack Buddies Programs and through Kids Meals. We give out nearly 300,000 books to children in pre-K through grade 5 each year.
- Age group: Elementary

### **Association for the Advancement of Mexican Americans**

- Book Use: Given to students, youth who are enrolled in the family prevention program, and placed in the neighborhood free little libraries
- Age groups: Baby/toddler, Elementary, Middle School, High School

### **Harris County Department of Education- Head Start**

- Book Use: Distributed to Head Start students to help build home libraries.
- Age groups: Baby/Toddler

### **The Women's Home**

- Book Use: To support the learning of high school students at our service center in Spring Branch
- Age groups: High School

### **Texas Children's Hospital**

- Book Use: To have on hand in the hospital
- Age groups: Baby/toddler, children
- Notes: **BOOKS NEED TO BE NEW**

### **Memorial Assistance Ministries**

- Book Use: 1) Distributing to clients in MAM's main location in Spring Branch, who come into the office seeking emergency financial assistance or other needs, including tax preparation, Immigration Legal Services, or Benefits Applications, 2) distributing to adults participating in MAM's virtual ESL and Citizenship classes. While parents are home with their children, having activities, like reading, that they can do together is more critical than ever.
- Age groups: Baby/toddler, Elementary, Middle School, High School

### **Ft. Bend Young Lawyers Association**

- Book Use: Normally it is sent to the courthouse for the family law court for the kids to read something during the proceedings. However, all leftover books are sent to local schools.
