Businesses cited for partnership

The Iowa Finance Authority and Passageway received national recognition for their partnership recently in Washington, D.C.

Passageway of Des Moines is a non-profit organization that supports individuals living with the effects of mental illness. During the past three years, 13 Passageway members have worked at Iowa Finance Authority in clerical support.

Iowa Finance Authority administers several affordable housing and water infrastructure financing programs.

The event featured 70 employers nationwide that provide jobs to clients from "clubhouse" organizations such as Passageway. Iowa Finance Authority is the only Iowa employer involved with the Transitional Employment Program at Passageway and the only Iowa organization to be recognized.
