Regular Member: *The IAJ bylaws provide that “[a]ny person who is licensed to practice law in any country, state or jurisdiction; is of good moral character; is engaged in any field or phase of advocacy and who is committed and devoted to the concept of a fair trial, the adversary system and a just result for the injured, the accused, and those whose rights are jeopardized, shall be eligible for regular membership Provided, however, that no person shall be eligible for regular membership in this Association who, for the most part, represents the defense of personal injury or workers’ compensation litigation.”*

Associate Member: IAJ recognizes that many attorneys who defend civil lawsuits or work comp claims support the Association’s efforts to preserve and improve our civil justice system and we have long welcomed such defense attorneys’ membership in the Association. Therefore, “Any person that for the most part represents the defense of personal injury or workers’ compensation litigation, who would otherwise be eligible for regular membership, shall be eligible for **associate membership**.”

Associate members are entitled to all benefits of regular membership with the exception that associate members are not entitled to hold office or participate on any IAJ list serve that the IAJ Board of Governors has chosen to limit to regular members only.” Currently, only regular members may participate on the IAJ Forum, Criminal Law and Workers’ Compensation list serves.
