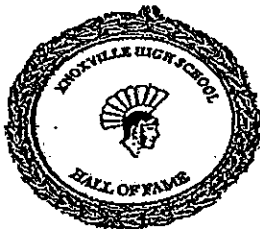

NOTE: The inductee or the designated representative therefor, and guest, will be complimentary.

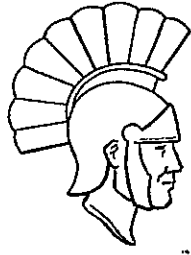

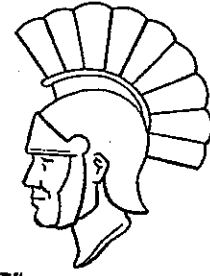
