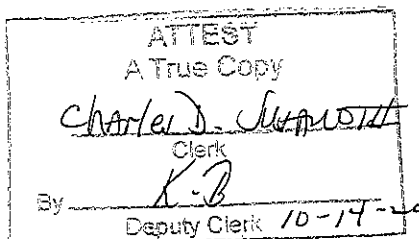

Due to a number of positive COVID-19 test results, in order to protect the health and safety of our children, our families and our employees, the Knox County Juvenile Court will be operating in a limited capacity. All in-person Juvenile Court proceedings except for the following will be suspended from October 5, 2020 until October 26, 2020.

- (1.) The Knox County Juvenile Court will be hearing Detention hearings, and any other delinquent cases involving juveniles currently being held in detention.
- (2.) Emergency Removal hearings.
- (3.) The Child Support Contempt docket or bond hearings involving incarcerated respondents will continue as scheduled.
- (4.) The Knox County Juvenile Court Clerk's office will remain open for business, accepting filings and payments.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED: that the Knox County Juvenile Court will be open in a limited capacity as described above.
