**AMENDED TEMPORARY GENERAL ORDER RELATING TO CIVIL MOTION HOUR**

---

Pursuant to orders of the Supreme Court of Kentucky related to court proceedings, and in consideration of those Orders, this Court hereby enters this Amended Temporary General Order Relating to Civil Motion Hour for the 36<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit.

1. This Court shall conduct all civil hearings remotely using Zoom or telephonic technology. There will be no in-person proceedings unless it is determined by the Court that remote technology would be impractical or impossible for the attorneys, parties or witnesses to use. Any requests for in-person hearings shall be granted only for good cause shown.

2. All civil motions shall be filed per the Court's Notice practice procedure.

3. All motions shall be filed electronically, by mail or by using the Circuit Clerk's Drop Box located at the front entry of the Courthouse. Further, a courtesy copy of the motion shall be emailed to my secretary at angelashort@kycourts.net.

4. All Motions to be heard on a Thursday Motion Hour must be filed no later than 4:00 P.M. on the Monday prior to the court date. If this deadline is not met, you shall file your notice for the court's next regularly scheduled Motion Hour.

5. Any Order requiring the remote attendance of a party or attorney shall have the same effect as requiring attendance in person and failure to appear remotely as ordered by this Court may be grounds for sanctions. Attorneys and unrepresented civil parties are expected to contact the court if there is any difficulty in joining a Zoom hearing being conducted by the Court.
