GENERAL ORDER  
Mandating Proper Notice of Filings for “Virtual” Court Proceedings

---

Kentucky Courts of Justice being required to conduct hearings virtually using video or telephonic conferencing whenever possible for the foreseeable future, pursuant to Kentucky Supreme Court Order 2020-39; it being necessary to continue providing court access to litigants and the public in a timely and reliable manner; it being further necessary to properly notify all parties of the ability and requirement to appear virtually; and Perry District Court being fully and sufficiently advised:

It is HEREBY ORDERED that parties filing any motion, petition, complaint, or other document requiring or related to a hearing to be scheduled in Perry District Court shall include the following notice on such document:

Pursuant to Kentucky Supreme Court Order 2020-39, all parties who are required or desire to participate in the above-captioned matter shall appear virtually via video or phone using Zoom, if possible. Please see the attached “General Order Requiring Virtual Appearance for All Perry District Matters (When Possible) Using Video or Telephonic Conferencing” for additional details. For further questions, please contact the Undersigned at the contact information provided below.<sup>1</sup>

It is FURTHER ORDERED that any such party, in addition to using the above-described notice language, shall include with the documents mailed to and/or served on the other party a copy of Perry District Court’s “General Order Requiring Virtual Appearance for All Perry District Matters (When Possible) Using Video or Telephonic Conferencing” (attached).

Requiring Virtual Appearance for All Perry District Matters (When Possible)  
Using Video or Telephonic Conferencing


Kentucky Courts of Justice being required to conduct hearings virtually using video or telephonic conferencing whenever possible for the foreseeable future, pursuant to Kentucky Supreme Court Order 2020-39; it being necessary to continue providing court access to litigants and the public in a timely and reliable manner; the health and safety of litigants and court employees being of paramount importance; and Perry District Court being fully and sufficiently advised:

It is HEREBY ORDERED that all parties wishing to observe or participate in cases before Perry District Court shall appear virtually using Zoom video/phone conferencing, whenever possible. To join, parties should either (1) download the “Zoom Cloud Meetings” application on their tablet or smart phone, OR (2) go to [zoom.us/join](https://zoom.us/join) on any laptop or desktop computer. If asked, the meeting ID is 971 4011 5386 and the password is 41701.

If video conferencing is not possible, parties should call in using any touch-tone phone by calling the Zoom/AT&T toll-free conferencing number (888-822-7517), and entering conference code 360826, when prompted. Parties should contact their attorney (if applicable) or the Court (606-435-6007) in advance if they need additional instructions on appearing virtually.

If you must appear in-person, only necessary parties are allowed to enter, no purses or other non-clear bags are allowed, *a face covering must be worn*, and proper social-distancing must be practiced at all times.
