

**FOUR ATTORNEYS INDUCTED INTO CONSUMER ATTORNEYS HALL OF FAME**  
**Bruce Broillet, David Glickman, Tom Stolpman and Ed Pollock are 2010 honorees**

LOS ANGELES — Consumer Attorneys of Los Angeles, the nation's largest local association of plaintiffs' attorneys, recognized four distinguished attorneys at its annual Hall of Fame Induction Dinner on June 23, 2010 at the Walt Disney Concert Hall in downtown Los Angeles. The 2010 Hall of Fame honorees were acknowledged for their significant contributions to the legal and professional society.

The four newest members of the Hall of Fame are Bruce Broillet, David Glickman, Tom Stolpman and the late Edward Pollock.

"These attorneys have substantially impacted the legal community, both in and out of the courtroom," said Garo Mardirossian, 2010 President of Consumer Attorneys Association of Los Angeles. "The plaintiff's legal bar would not be where it is today without the dedication of these men."

The 2010 honorees include:

- **Bruce Broillet – Greene Broillet & Wheeler**  
Broillet represents plaintiffs in such areas as business litigation, products liability, professional malpractice, personal injury and wrongful death. He has taken a significant leadership role in Consumer Attorneys Association of Los Angeles, serving as President (1994) and on the Board of Governors. He previously received two prestigious attorney awards: Trial Lawyer of the Year and the Ted Horn Memorial Award.
- **David Glickman – Glickman & Glickman**  
Glickman has practiced for more than 50 years and tried more than 350 cases to jury verdict, handling complex business litigation cases, real property and consumer tort matters. He has been an active member of Consumer Attorneys Association of Los Angeles since 1960, serving as a member of the organization's Board of Governors for more than 35 years. He has also been honored as the Association's Trial Lawyer of the Year and Ted Horn Memorial Award recipient.
- **Edward Pollock (deceased) – Pollock, Pollock Fay & Baum**  
Pollock formed the firm Pollock and Pollock that later became Pollock, Pollock Fay & Baum, and was renowned for his legislative advocacy and *amicus curiae* work on behalf of other trial attorneys. He was one of the small group of attorneys who created the plaintiffs' trial bar, helping found the organizations that later evolved into Consumer Attorneys of Los Angeles and Consumer Attorneys of California. He served as the fifth president of the Los Angeles organization and the second president of the state association.

- **Thomas Stolpman – Stolpman, Krissman, Elber & Silver**  
Stolpman has earned a national reputation representing seriously injured clients in substantial damage tort cases. His areas of emphasis include insurance bad faith, as well as construction site accident and maritime accident litigation. For more than 30 years, he has been a member of Consumer Attorneys of Los Angeles, serving as its president in 1989 and receiving its Trial Lawyer of the Year and Ted Horn Memorial Awards.
