

This is from the Court regarding MSCs and submission of the MSC brief.

Lawyers should know to report on the date of the MSC to the Department the case has been assigned to and to bring the MSC brief with them.

The reason why the Court doesn't want the MSC brief before the day of the MSC is they don't know where the settlement conference will go until that morning. The parties will go to the Department the case has been assigned to, answer ready for the MSC, be sent to Dept. 1 for assignment, and then to a judge for the MSC. The decision on who is the MSC judge will be based on availability that morning.
