- Must be a current Member of the Maricopa County Bar Association Paralegal Division;
- Must be an Arizona resident;
- Must be enrolled for a minimum of six semester hours in the school's paralegal program;
- Must intend to pursue a career as a paralegal;
- Must have an established G.P.A. of **3.0** or higher from courses taken at the school's paralegal program and be in current good academic standing;
- Must have completed a minimum of 6 credits of paralegal courses at the school's paralegal program prior to the start of the Fall semester and have completed a minimum of 12 credits by the conclusion of that Fall semester;
- The student must include a current unofficial transcript as well as provide a copy of their class schedule for the Fall semester that would verify the required minimum of credits would be completed;
- Applications must be made on the approved form, include all documentation listed on the application form, and signed by applicant;
