Eligibility

- Must be a current Arizona Resident
- Must be a current student member of the Maricopa County Bar Association Paralegal Division
- Must intend to pursue a career as a paralegal
- Must meet the following academic requirements within a formal paralegal program:
 - Must have completed a minimum of 6 credit hours prior to the start of the Fall 2020 Semester
 - Must be currently enrolled for a minimum of 6 semester hours
 - Must have a current minimum G.P.A. of 3.0
 - Must be in good academic standing

How to Apply

- Submit an Official Application with required documentation (see Official Application for list of required documentation) by September 30, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.
- All Applications must be submitted on an Official Application form, must include all required documentation and must be signed.
- Applications may be mailed or emailed but *must be received* by the deadline to be considered.

Additional Rules and Regulations:

Scholarship funds in the amount of \$1,000.00 are sent directly to the school in the scholarship recipient's name to be used toward tuition, fees, and/or books. No scholarship funds will be paid or reimbursed directly to the scholarship recipient.

In the event that a scholarship recipient ceases to be enrolled in a paralegal program or is enrolled for less than 6 credit hours at any time prior to full use of the scholarship funds, any remaining funds shall be retained by the school and awarded to another applicant as selected by the MCBA Paralegal Division.

The scholarship recipients are required to attend the MCBA Paralegal Conference on November 13, 2020, where their accomplishment will be honored. The Conference registration fee will be waived for the scholarship recipients.
