
JUDGMENT ENTRY

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic the General Division of the Mahoning County Court of Common Pleas initially suspended all jury trials on March 16, 2020 for a period of two weeks. The Court took further action on March 24, 2020 and indefinitely suspended all jury trials until further order from the Court.


The Court during this time period has implemented safety measures based on following the guidelines and recommendations of Governor Mike DeWine, the Ohio Supreme Court and the Mahoning County Health Department. The Court also modified its operating schedule to decrease face-to-face interactions and continually practices social distancing when court proceedings occur.


