This Court joins the Ohio State Supreme Court and the Federal District Court for the Northern District of Ohio in recognizing the public health hazards posed by the Corona Virus Pandemic. The Court takes judicial notice of the fact that Corona Virus infection rates and hospitalization rates in the State of Ohio are at or near an all-time high. The Court further takes judicial notice of the Mahoning County Board of Health Stay at Home Advisory.

An employee, with access to the public and non-public facilities of the Court, has tested positive for the Corona Virus. Said employee had extensive contact with court facilities and equipment. Said employee further had extensive contact with court personnel.

In order to meet the Court's obligation of safeguarding court employees, litigants and the public, County Court No. 3 and County Court No. 5 shall be closed effective @ 2:00 PM on Wednesday, December 2, 2020 through Monday, December 7, 2020. The Courts will reopen on Tuesday, December 8, 2020. Accordingly, this Court continues all criminal proceedings including but not limited to pre-trials, trials and preliminary hearings until the next available date. The continuances are granted pursuant to R.C. 2945.72(H) and constitute a reasonable continuance granted other than upon the accused's own motion.
