

**Instructions for Candidates Interested in Being Considered for the
Judicial District Court Vacancy in the 26th Judicial District**

If you are interested in being considered for the judicial vacancy, you must complete and submit the form below that certifies you: are in good standing with the North Carolina State Bar and the Mecklenburg County Bar; reside within the 26th Judicial District and are duly authorized to practice law within the 26th Judicial District; are eligible to serve as a District Court Judge for the State of North Carolina, 26th Judicial District; and are submitting your name (as you would like it to appear on the ballot) as a candidate for the seat left vacant by Judge Ronald L. Chapman.

Note: N.C.G.S. Section 7A-133 (as amended by Session Law 2018-14) divides the district courts of the 26th Judicial District into sub-districts but does not impact the vacancy at this time. Upon expiration of the vacancy, the individual appointed to this vacancy can only seek reelection for a seat in the sub-district in which he or she resides.
