MAJ Announces Judicial Endorsements

Trial lawyers back Judge Kameshia Gant for 6th Circuit, Judge Alyia Hakim for 39th District

LANSING—The Michigan Association for Justice today announced the endorsements of **Judge Kameshia D. Gant** for 6th Circuit Court in Oakland County and **Judge Alyia Hakim** for 39th District Court in Roseville and Fraser.

“MAJ is proud to endorse two outstanding, well-qualified judges who demonstrate every day their commitment to a fair and open justice system in Michigan,” MAJ President Donna MacKenzie said. “Judge Gant and Judge Hakim represent the highest standards of the legal profession, and we urge voters to return them to the bench this November.”

Judge Gant was appointed by Governor Gretchen Whitmer to the 6th Circuit Court in April 2019. She received her bachelor’s degree from the University of Michigan and her Juris Doctor degree from Wayne State University. Previously, she was a solo practitioner with Gant Law, PLLC and a public defender.

Judge Hakim was appointed by Gov. Whitmer to the 39th District Court in November 2019. Prior to her appointment, Hakim was a partner attorney with Hakim & Hakim, PLLC and of counsel for Aloia & Associates, PC. Her practice specialized in criminal defense, estate planning, juvenile law, and family law. She holds a Bachelor of Science from Western Michigan University and a Juris Doctor degree from Wayne State University.

MAJ has previously announced endorsements for Chief Justice Bridget Mary McCormack and Elizabeth Welch for Michigan Supreme Court and Judge Michelle Rick for Michigan Court of Appeals - Fourth District.
