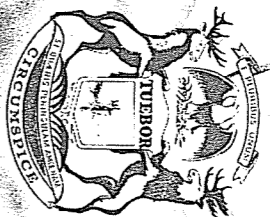

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
OFFERED AS A MEMORIAL FOR
MR. JAMES A. TUCK

WHEREAS, As a partner in the law firm of Goodman, Eden, Millender, and Bedrosian in Detroit, he consistently epitomized the finest qualities of humanity. He was well known for his hard work, energy, and spirit, as well as his concern for the rights of the individual; and

WHEREAS, In addition to his tireless efforts to champion the rights of his clients, Jim Tuck exemplified professionalism in all of his myriad endeavors. His extensive bar activities were truly evidence of his dedication to the noble tenets of the law; and


