MAJ Announces 2020 Primary Endorsements for Michigan House

LANSING — The Michigan Association for Justice (MAJ) today announced its 2020 candidate primary endorsements for the Michigan House of Representatives.

Endorsements were based on voting records for incumbents and a comprehensive candidate questionnaire. All candidates, regardless of party, were invited to return a questionnaire and apply for an endorsement. Judicial candidates were invited to return a judicial candidate questionnaire and meet with MAJ's Judicial Qualification Committee. Judicial endorsements for Michigan Supreme Court, Michigan Court of Appeals, and local seats were previously announced.
