Michigan Association for Justice Calls on Governor Snyder to Veto Bill Making Municipalities Immune from Sidewalk Injury Claims

LANSING — The Michigan Association for Justice today called on Governor Snyder to veto HB 4686, legislation that would effectively make municipalities completely immune from lawsuits related to injuries caused by faulty and dangerous sidewalks.

“HB 4686 is dangerous for Michigan,” MAJ President Tom Waun said. “This bill would make our communities less safe and less livable especially for the young, the elderly, and persons with disabilities.”
