# **Speaker Application for MATA Education Programs**

MATA offers continuing legal education (CLE) programs on a variety of legal topics. Each year, our programs expand to meet the needs of our members, and we are continually seeking new speakers and topics to round out our programs, including our annual convention each June, in addition to webinars and seminars across the state.

### **Speaker Qualifications**

MATA is seeking knowledgeable and articulate individuals willing to share their expertise and real-world experience with members. Keys to a successful presentation include learning objectives, practical applications, use of visual aids and preparation of a speaker paper.

For compliance with CLE accreditation requirements, all speakers must submit written materials for inclusion in the course materials to supplement their presentations.

Speakers who teach at MATA Education programs are volunteers. MATA does not pay an honorarium to speakers, and in-state speakers are responsible for all travel-related expenses. Also, lawyers selected to present at convention programs must pay the convention registration fee to receive CLE credit beyond that of their speaking segments.

#### **Submission of Proposals**

Proposals are accepted on a rolling basis for ALL programs; however please note the following deadlines for the upcoming annual conventions.

- Currency of subject matter/topic to MATA members
- > Practical application

If your proposal is selected, you will be contacted by MATA staff and provided with detailed information about your responsibilities and participation as a speaker. All proposals will be added to our faculty listings and may be called on for future MATA education programs.
