

MEMORIAL RESOLUTION

FOR

NORMAN DOW LANE, SR.

(1935 to 2003)

Norman Dow Lane, Sr. died on April 20, 2003, at the age of 67 years. He was born in Portland, Sumner County, Tennessee, on November 20, 1935.

Norman Dow Lane, Sr. graduated from Portland High School in 1954, and then attended Western Kentucky University at Bowling Green, and received a Bachelor's Degree in History in 1958. Thereafter, he graduated from the University of Tennessee School of Law in 1960. While attending law school, he joined the Reserve Officers Training Corps and upon graduation served two years in the Judge Advocate General Corps attached to the Army Corps of Engineers until his honorable discharge in 1961.

Norman Dow Lane, Sr. began his law career in Nashville with a position as Assistant United States Attorney during the years 1961-1962. He then began the private practice of law in Nashville with the law firm of Lester, Loser, Mondelli, Hildebrand, Nolan, Lane & Underhill. Mr. Lane also practiced law in Portland, Tennessee, his hometown, and became the City Attorney of Portland 1968.

Norman Dow Lane, Sr. was a member of the Association of Trial Lawyers of America, the Nashville Bar Association and the Tennessee Trial Lawyers Association.


Norman Dow Lane, Sr. enjoyed reading, and especially the history of Rome and biographies that involved Thomas Jefferson.
