JAMES R. LINEBAUGH

The lawyers of the Nashville Bar Association are gathered on this November 18, 1993, to pay our respect and tribute to the memory of our brethren, James R. Linebaugh, who passed to his eternal rest on October 19, 1992, at the age of 64 years.

Jim Linebaugh was born in Nashville, Tennessee and attended school in Nashville, graduating from West High School in 1947. After graduating from West, he attended the University of Tennessee and received his law degree in 1951. He then went into the military service and served with the Judge Advocate General's Corp for the next two years. He returned to Nashville to private practice.

Jim married the former Gail Greene and of this union was born Penny Linebaugh Newcomb and Leslie Linebaugh.

Jim worked in the insurance adjusting business for several years and then worked for American Insurance Company with Leslie Mondelli. He subsequently went to Life & Casualty Insurance Company where he worked in the Claim Department for many years. When life & Casualty Insurance Company merged with National Life and was converted into American General Insurance Company, Jim was made the Claim Manager where he served faithfully for many years.

Jim loved tennis and was on the board of the Nashville Tennis Association for seven years and served as President of the Nashville Tennis Association during the year 1990, and he was also Treasurer of the Tennessee Tennis Association. He worked for several years with the International Claims Association and was elected President of the International Claims Association for 1986-1987. Jim had many accomplishments during his all too brief life and was dedicated to his family and to his career.

Now, therefore, it is respectfully moved by this Committee that the foregoing Resolution dedicated to the memory of James R.
