### NBA Releases Results of Member Poll for 20th Judicial District Chancery Court Vacancy

**Nashville, TN** – The Nashville Bar Association released the results today of a member poll for candidates being considered for the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Chancery Court Vacancy in Davidson County.

A survey ballot was conducted online, and 738 responses were received by the deadline of November 29, 2018. All bar members are polled and the results are reported as raw ballot results with no attempt to extrapolate results.
