We have come here to honor the memory of this fine brother and gentleman tonight as one of our true honorable departed brothers of the Nashville Bar during the past year. Ramon E. Womack was born on March 25, 1925 in Davidson County, Tennessee, one of the four boys of the late James and Ethel Womack. Ramon was a devoted husband, father, grandfather and brother who loved his family greatly.

Ramon Womack was honorably discharged from serving his country in WW II and saw duty with the Seventh Army in the European Theater.

This fine man graduated from the YMCA Law School on June 10, 1964 while working days in the controllers office of the State of Tennessee to support his family. After graduating from the "Y" Law School, he began his private practice soon thereafter on Nolensville Road. He had been in practice with several other lawyers. At one time, a firm of three was with Harold Fisher, now practicing in Manchester, Tennessee and Tom. Harris, now practicing in Ashland City, Tennessee. His last association was with Clarence Beaty, now deceased.

Ramon E. Womack cared about his community and its people. If a person came to him, unable to pay a fee but needing a lawyer, Ramon would do Pro Bono work.

The family, who he loved dearly, along with his many friends, both in his personal and
