Article Submission Guidelines

*NJAJ accepts articles for publication
in our monthly newsletter, In Brief.*

*Following are guidelines, which we ask that
you follow when submitting articles.*

1. Articles must be no longer than 900 words and double-spaced.

2. Infomercials will not be considered for publication. Articles should provide either news about a product, service or resource or information helpful to attorneys in their practice of law. Suggested topics include, but are not limited to: technology in law, marketing strategies, practice tips, trial advocacy (e.g. opening statements, cross-examination of witnesses), resources (websites, experts).

3. Authors should include a brief biography of themselves.

4. All submissions should be sent to Mark Perkiss at NJAJ at mperkiss@nj-justice.org in Microsoft Word or text format. Graphics or other artwork will be accepted.

5. Please submit your article 30 days before desired publication. NJAJ reserves the right to schedule publication based on space or other considerations.

6. NJAJ reserves the right to edit any submission published in its monthly newsletter.
