One of the unique services of the Oakland County Bar Association is its Mentor Program that matches new or less-experienced attorneys with a seasoned practitioner. The Mentor Program was designed to:

- assist new attorneys by providing someone to whom you can turn to ask questions;
- introduce you to other members of the Bar and Bench;
- allow mentors an opportunity to accompany you to Association events on occasion; and
- assist you in getting involved in OCBA activities and taking advantage of OCBA membership.

The Mentor Program is not designed to be a job placement service nor is it meant to be used to assist you with individual cases when you need a legal question answered. Instead, this program is meant to assist you in meeting your peers in the legal community, to have an experienced attorney who can provide advice on your long-term career goals and opportunities, and to hopefully evolve into a long-term professional relationship.

How the Mentor Program works:

When you are admitted and become a member of the Oakland County Bar Association, you are given an opportunity to request a mentor. You will be matched with a mentor based upon areas of practice in which you are interested. It is the responsibility of the assigned mentor to contact you.
