Arthur H. Bryant Public Justice Award

In 1991, the Oregon Trial Lawyers Association Board of Governors voted to recognize an individual or group who, throughout the previous year, strove to create a more just society through creative litigation and innovative work with the broader public interest community.

In 2003 the award was renamed after Arthur H. Bryant, the Executive Director of Public Justice (formerly Trial Lawyers for Public Justice). Arthur was severely injured in a car crash as he left the 2002 OTLA Convention; he has since recovered and is Chairman of Public Justice, where he remains a champion of justice and inspiration to OTLA members.
