Trial lawyers are active volunteer members in their communities and are generous in giving back outside of practicing law to keep Oregonians safe, secure and healthy.

OTLA Cares is administered through our non-profit arm, the Oregon Jury Project, with funding from our individual, generous members. Grants from OTLA Cares are distributed to like-minded non-profits who believe in access to justice for all Oregonians and provide services to make our communities safer and healthier.

For example, over the past 7 years OTLA Cares has been a major donor to the Legacy Trauma Nurses Bike Helmet program offering reduced cost (\$5) or FREE bike helmets to those in need. OTLA members, alongside trauma nurses, attend weekend community events and properly fit bikers with new helmets. Research shows that bicycle helmets are 88% effective in preventing deaths and lessen head injuries by 65% when worn properly. OTLA Cares has also been a sponsor of the Classroom Law Project, a nonprofit dedicated to preparing youth to become active, engaged and informed participants in our democracy through innovative programs that inspire over 880 teachers and 63,000 students across Oregon.
